St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School was established in 1925. The original teachings of kindness and service embody the students of today. Graduates of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School grow up to be highly contributing members of society. They understand the value that hope and kindness have in connecting communities.

St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School knows the necessity in “connecting to one another.” In this spirit, the Hope Scholarship was established. The Hope Scholarship helps students, in need of tuition assistance, attend St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School. The scholarship provides \$2,000 toward a student’s tuition and fees every year they attend St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School. This is in addition to any other financial aid they may qualify for.

St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School caters to many students who are learning English for the first time. 74% of students at St. Vincent de Paul School are of Latino background and 41% of students at the school qualify for Title 1 reading services. The income levels for most families qualify them for free or reduced lunch and 98% of the students qualify for tuition assistance.

The scholarship is named “Hope” after the attitude our school brings to the community. Our students are hopeful for their future and the future of their families. St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School has a mission to bring all families together. We believe the language and financial barriers should not be barriers to a Catholic education. To support this mission, we rely on donors like you to instill “Hope” in every student that walks through our doors.
